

## **CAPE BAR PRO BONO POLICY**

(as amended by the AGM on 17 April 2024)

1. Advocates are required to render community service amounting to such number of hours as may be imposed from time to time in terms of section 29 of the Legal Practice Act 28 of 2014 (“the LPA”) read with the Regulations published under Government Gazette notice number R 1183 of 29 October 2018 as amended (collectively “the LPA community service requirements”).
2. The Cape Bar will no longer impose parallel pro bono work requirements on its members. The Cape Bar is also not responsible for supervising or enforcing compliance with the LPA community service requirements.
3. The Pro Bono Committee is tasked with creating opportunities for members to enable them to comply with the LPA’s community service requirements and to provide other deserving *pro bono* work. Members may notify the Pro Bono Committee of their specific areas of interest for this purpose.
